1 ROUND CRUISE TO MAPLEDURHAM

Turning by the weir at Mapledurham Lock, you can take in the classic Thames scenery and rushing waters of the weir.

3 A DAY OUT TO GORING & STREATLEY

Our extended day cruise passes through Pangbourne and into some of the most unspoilt stretches of the Thames where the river valley was cut sharply through the downs during the last Ice Age. Steep woodland escarpments create the wonderful view which we think inspired 'Wild Wood' in Kenneth Graham's Wind in the Willows. Goring and Streatley are some of the most traditional Thames-side villages to explore on arrival.

2 EXPERIENCE WIND IN THE WILLOWS COUNTRY
